



## 2025 Frequently Asked Questions

### **WHAT ARE THE FEES TO ENTER EACH RODEO?**

- \$12 event entry fee per rodeo
- \$17 timer fee for all barrel and pole bending events (per event, per rodeo)
- \$20 arena fee for members and \$30 for non-members (once per rodeo)
- \$15 stock fee for goats for Jr, Senior & Super Senior
- \$7.50 stock fee for goats for Tiny Tot & Pee-Wee
- \$20 stock fee for roping stock (sorting, team roping, ribbon roping, breakaway, steer wrestling, tie-down)
- \$20 stock fee for chute dogging
- \$35 stock fee per stock event for Tiny Tot, Pee-Wee & Junior Bulls
- \$45 Stock fee per stock event for Senior & Super Senior Bulls
- \$35 stock fee per stock event for Tiny Tot & Junior Bareback, Ranch Bronc and Saddle Ponies/Steers
- \$45 stock fee per stock event for Senior and Super Senior Bareback, Ranch Bronc and Saddle Bronc
- \$20 stock fee for sheep
- \$15 IMRA fee per rodeo for those qualifying for the IMRA.

### **WHAT IS THE MEMBERSHIP FEES AND REQUIREMENTS?**

- \$75 per child and \$50 for each additional child (No family household maximum)
- To qualify for the finals the membership fee must be paid before rodeo points can count.

### **WHAT IS REQUIRED TO QUALIFY FOR FINALS?**

- The contestant must attend & compete in 5 rodeos (Each event of your choosing must also have been competed in 5 times, to qualify in that event for finals)
- The contestant must fundraise \$300 (Raffle Tickets/\$5 each)
- A parent, family member, or the contestant must volunteer for 1 event at 2 rodeos.

All rodeos will be hosted by Crazy P Arena in Cedartown, Ga.



## **WHAT IS THE ORDER OF EVENTS?**

Senior & Super Senior Bareback Riding

*Lil' Buckaroo Arena Opens with the following happening simultaneously:*

*Tiny Tot Goat Tail Untying*

Pee-Wee Mini Ponies & Junior Ponies Bareback Riding

*Tiny Tot Dummy Roping*

Junior Bull Riding

*Pee-Wee Goat Tying on the Ground*

Pee-Wee Bull Riding

Tiny Tot Bull Riding

*Junior Dummy Roping*

Pee-Wee & Tiny Tot Mutton Busting (If you are in Pee-Wee Mutton AND Pee-Wee Dummy Roping, move immediately to the Lil' Buckaroo Arena after your sheep ride is complete)

*Pee-Wee Dummy Roping*

Senior & Super Senior Saddle Bronc Riding

Pee-Wee Mini Ponies & Junior Ponies Saddle Bronc Riding

Junior & Pee-Wee Chute Dogging

Super Senior & Senior Chute Dogging

### **WHAT EVENTS ARE OFFERED PER AGE DIVISION?**

RockN'5L Rodeo Company -Youth Division is sanctioned with the following associations: IMRA

**\*You must sign up with their associations directly to qualify for their yearend finals – our membership is for RockN'5L only. We do not accept IMRA membership forms or responsible for turning them in to their office.**

\*Our age groups are the same as IMRA.

Qualifications for AA Boy and AA girl: must compete in at least 3 events, at a minimum of 5 of the 8 rodeos. Saddle will be awarded to one boy and girl in each age group with the exception of the Tiny Tots age division. RockN'5L Rodeo does NOT award a reserve award in the All-Around categories.

Competing up in an age division- anyone can compete up, but you can never compete down. Once you compete up, you can't move back down.

Awards- top 5 in each age group will receive an award at finals -1st place award being a belt buckle and the All-Around Cowboy and All-Around Cowgirl will receive saddles in each of the 4 age divisions. (Tiny Tot age division does NOT qualify for the All-Around Category.)

All ages are as of January 1st of the rodeo season. We must have a copy of the birth certificate on file to prove your child's age.

Age Groups and events offered per age group are as follows:

### **TINY TOTS- AGES 5 & UNDER**

Events Offered:

- Barrels- boys and girls compete together
- Poles- boys and girls compete together
- Goat Tail Untying - boys and girls compete together
- Dummy Roping- boys and girls compete together
- Mutton Busting- 60 lb. weight limit -boys and girls compete together
- Bull Riding-boys and girls compete together

- ⊙ You must weight 60 lbs. or less at the first rodeo with less than a 10 lb. weight gain by finals to continue competing on the sheep. Absolutely no one weighing over 70 lbs. will be allowed to ride sheep.
- ⊙ Contestants must be weighed at the beginning of each rodeo for the sheep riding.
- ⊙ Tiny Tot contestants will be allowed to ride in both mutton busting and bull riding if they chose to do so.
- ⊙ No points awarded for this age group, and everyone will receive a buckle at finals if you're a member.
- ⊙ Your child may be led in for barrels and poles for this age group, but everyone must be in full western attire.
- ⊙ IMRA only qualifies girls for breakaway and barrels.
- ⊙ IMRA qualifies boys and girls for rough stock, and they compete at the finals together, therefore they compete together with 5L.



## **PEE WEE- AGES 6-8**

### Events Offered:

- Barrels- boys and girls compete together
  - Poles- boys and girls compete together
  - Goat Tying on the ground- boys and girls compete together
  - Dummy Roping- boys and girls compete together
  - Chute Dogging- boys and girls compete together
  - Mutton Busting- boys and girls compete together-65 lb. weight limit
  - Bull Riding- boys and girls compete together
  - Mini Pony Broncs- boys and girls compete together –80lb weight limit
  - Ranch Bronc- boys and girls compete together ---80lb weight limit
- ⊙ Contestants must be weighed at the beginning of each rodeo for the sheep riding
- ⊙ You must weight 60 lbs. or less at the first rodeo with less than a 10 lb. weight gain by finals to continue competing on the sheep. Absolutely no one weighing over 70lbs. will be allowed to ride sheep.
- ⊙ You can move up to bull riding from mutton busting at any time during the season, but your points will NOT carry over from sheep to bulls.
- ⊙ IMRA only qualifies girls for breakaway and barrels.
- ⊙ IMRA qualifies boys and girls for rough stock, and they compete at the finals together, therefore they compete together with 5L.

## **JUNIORS – AGES 9-11**

### Events Offered:

- Barrels -boys and girls compete together
  - Poles -boys and girls compete together
  - Goat Tying- boys and girls compete separately -boys can tie with a hoey
  - Breakaway Roping- boys and girls compete together
  - Chute Dogging -Boys and girls compete together
  - Bull Riding -Boys and girls compete together
  - Saddle & Bareback- Boys and girls compete together
  - Steer Bareback & Saddle-Boys and girls compete together
  - Team Roping –Boys and girls compete together and can pair with anyone from Junior, Senior & Super Senior Age Groups
  - Dally Ribbon Roping- Boys and girls compete together and can pair with anyone from Junior, Senior & Super Senior Age Groups
  - Ranch Bronc- Boys and girls compete together
  - Ranch Sorting- Boys and girls compete together and can pair with anyone from Junior, Senior & Super Senior Age Groups
- ⊙ IMRA qualifies boys and girls for rough stock, and they compete at the finals together, therefore they compete together with 5L.
- ⊙ IMRA qualifies girls for breakaway, barrels, pole bending & goat tying.



## **SENIORS - AGES 12-14**

### Events Offered:

- Barrels -Boys and Girls compete together
  - Poles- Boys and Girls compete together
  - Goat Tying -Boys and girls compete separately – boys must tie with a hoey
  - Breakaway Roping- Boys and girls compete together
  - Chute Dogging -Boys and girls compete together
  - Bull Riding - Boys and girls compete together
  - Bareback Riding - Boys and girls compete together
  - Saddle bronc Riding- Boys and girls compete together
  - Tie Down Roping-Boys only
  - Team Roping- Boys and girls compete together and can pair with anyone from Junior, Senior & Super Senior Age Groups.
  - Dally Ribbon Roping- Boys and girls compete together and can pair with anyone from Junior, Senior & Super Senior Age Groups
  - Ranch Bronc- Boys and girls compete together
  - Ranch Sorting - Boys and girls compete together and can pair with anyone from Junior, Senior & Super Senior Age Groups
- ⊙ IMRA qualifies boys and girls for rough stock, and they compete at the finals together, therefore they compete together with 5L.
- ⊙ IMRA qualifies girls for breakaway, barrels, pole bending & goat tying.

## **SUPER SENIORS-AGES 15-18 (19 IF STILL IN HIGH SCHOOL)**

### Events Offered:

- Barrels -Boys and Girls compete together
- Poles- Boys and Girls compete together
- Goat Tying -Girls only
- Breakaway Roping- Girls only
- Chute Dogging -Boys and girls compete together
- Steer Wrestling - Boys only (if we get enough interest) bulldogger would be responsible for providing his own hazer if one is not available.
- Bull Riding - Boys and girls compete together
- Bareback Riding - Boys and girls compete together
- Saddle bronc Riding- Boys and girls compete together
- Tie Down Roping-Boys only
- Team Roping- Boys and girls compete together and can pair with anyone from Junior, Senior & Super Senior Age Groups.



- Dally Ribbon Roping- Boys and girls compete together and can pair with anyone from Junior, Senior & Super Senior Age Groups
- Ranch Bronc- Boys and girls compete together
- Ranch Sorting - Boys and girls compete together and can pair with anyone from Junior, Senior & Super Senior Age Groups

- ⊙ IMRA qualifies boys and girls for rough stock, and they compete at the finals together, therefore they compete together with 5L.
- ⊙ IMRA qualifies girls for breakaway, barrels, pole bending & goat tying.

### **ENTRY FEE EXAMPLE FOR A ROCKN'5L MEMBER:**

Junior Goats- \$15 stock fee, \$20 arena fee (only paid once per rodeo), \$12 event entry fee. -\$47.00 total

Senior & Super Senior Bull riding- \$45 stock fee, \$20 arena fee (only paid once per rodeo), \$12 event entry fee. -\$77 total.

Barrels-\$20 arena fee (paid once per rodeo) \$12 event entry fee, \$17 timer fee -\$49.00 total

### **ENTRY FEE EXAMPLE FOR A NON ROCKN'5L MEMBER:**

(The only thing that changes is the arena fee from \$20 to \$30)

Junior Goats- \$15 stock fee, \$30 arena fee (only paid once per rodeo), \$12 event entry fee. -\$57.00 total

Senior & Super Senior Bull riding- \$45 stock fee, \$30 arena fee (only paid once per rodeo), \$12 event entry fee -\$87 total.

Barrels-\$30 arena fee (paid once per rodeo) \$12 event entry fee, \$17 timer fee -\$59.00 total.

**Qualifiers for IMRA pay \$15 on top of the entry fees once per rodeo.**
